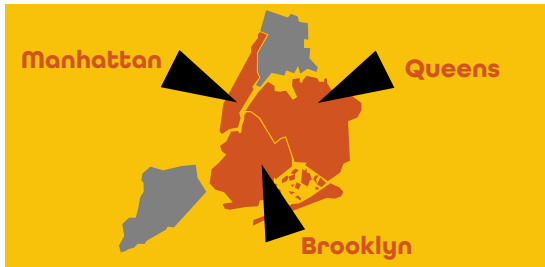

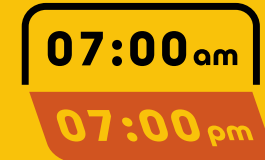
## BE MINDFUL OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD

**Manhattan (42%), Brooklyn (29%) and Queens (18%)** reported the most accidents between 2003-2016.<sup>(1)</sup>



## BE MINDFUL OF PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS

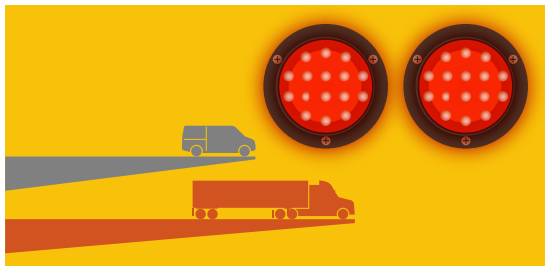
67% of accidents involving **pedestrians and cyclists** occurred on **designated truck routes**.<sup>(1)</sup>



## BE MINDFUL OF THE TIME

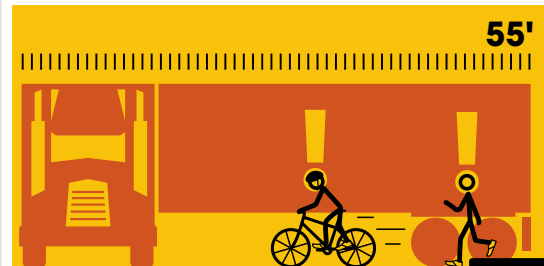
**Close to 80% of accidents** occurred between **7am and 7pm**, with 25% occurring midday.<sup>(1)</sup>

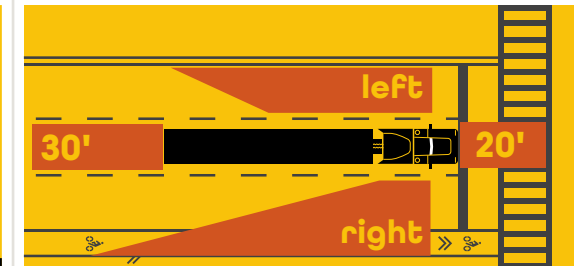
## PAY CLOSE ATTENTION WHEN CROSSING STREETS OR CHANGING LANES

Be careful when crossing streets or changing lanes: **Large trucks take 40% longer to stop than smaller vehicles.**<sup>(2)</sup>



## PAY CLOSE ATTENTION AT INTERSECTIONS

**Large trucks** have a **wide turning radius of 55 Ft.**



## PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO BLIND SPOTS

Stay out of blind spots when walking or cycling: **There are 4 blind spots on large trucks where the driver cannot see you.**<sup>(2)</sup>
